Encouraging **Educational** Achievement

77% of Littles improved or maintained their academic performance

Supporting **Emotional** Well-Being

35% of Littles saw reliable improvement, and an additional 42% no change, in their depressive symptoms

100% of Littles avoided substance use

Building **Life** Skills

94% of Littles reported better or sustained social competence (positive peer relationships)
